
PET OVERPOPULATION

- TWO UNCONTROLLED BREEDING CATS CAN YIELD, IN TEN YEARS, OVER 80 MILLION CATS.
- MILLIONS OF UNWANTED AND HOMELESS CATS ARE BORN IN THE U.S. EACH YEAR. DURING THE PEAK OF THE KITTEN SEASON -FROM LATE APRIL TO SEPTEMBER - HUMANE SHELTERS KILL UNWANTED AND ABANDONED CATS ATE THE RATE OF ONE PER MINUTE.
